Indeed there are around 140 distilleries in the area. Rocky, pure, dry soil is very important for the cultivation of lavender, although the rocks should not be too large. With no irrigation this kind of soil is only suitable for lavender and a few kinds of wheat.

## The history and uses of lavender

The use of lavender goes all the way back to the Greeks and Romans. The Romans would scent their bath water with it as well as use it to improve the smell of washed clothes. The botanical name 'lavendula' comes from the latin 'lavare' meaning 'to wash'.

As well as being widely added to perfumes and other scented products, Lavender is one essential oil that can be used in every home, and it's it has many uses!
