Northern Lights Black Spruce essential oil comes from Young Living's Northern Lights Farm in British Columbia, Canada. Picea mariana grows throughout Canada, including all three arctic territories. The whole tree is steam distilled to produce this essential oil.

Diffuse this rich, woodsy, and invigorating scent during meditation to create a fresh aromatic atmosphere. Black spruce is also a great addition to skin care products which can be applied topically to help improve the appearance of dry skin or to help maintain the appearance of healthylooking skin.

Northern Lights Black Spruce can be applied anywhere, including to the bottoms of feet, along the spine, back of neck, or used for massage. This oil includes the naturally occurring constituents alpha-pinene, camphene, and betapinene and is an important ingredient in many products, including Valor II[®], Shutran[™], Peace & Calming II[™] and Light The Fire[™] essential oil blends.
